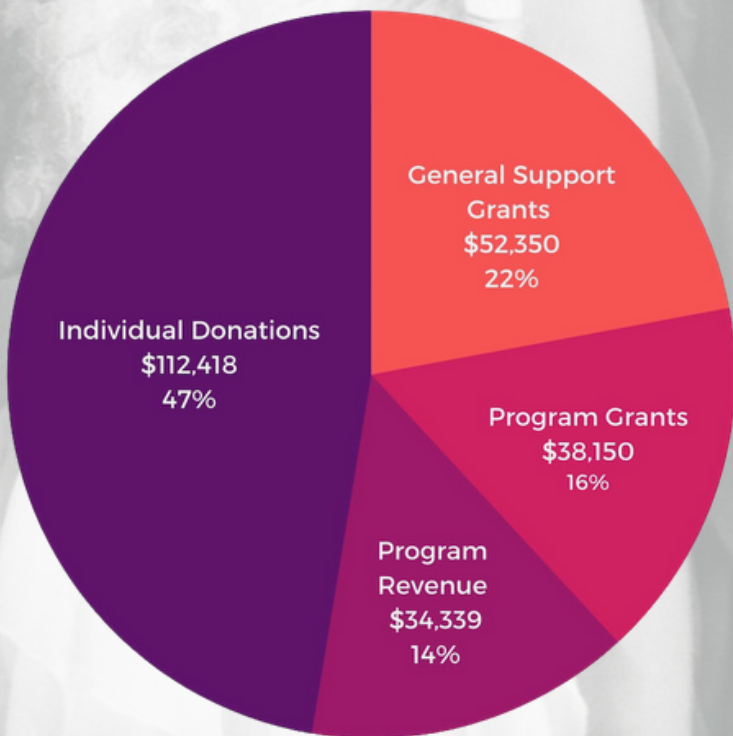

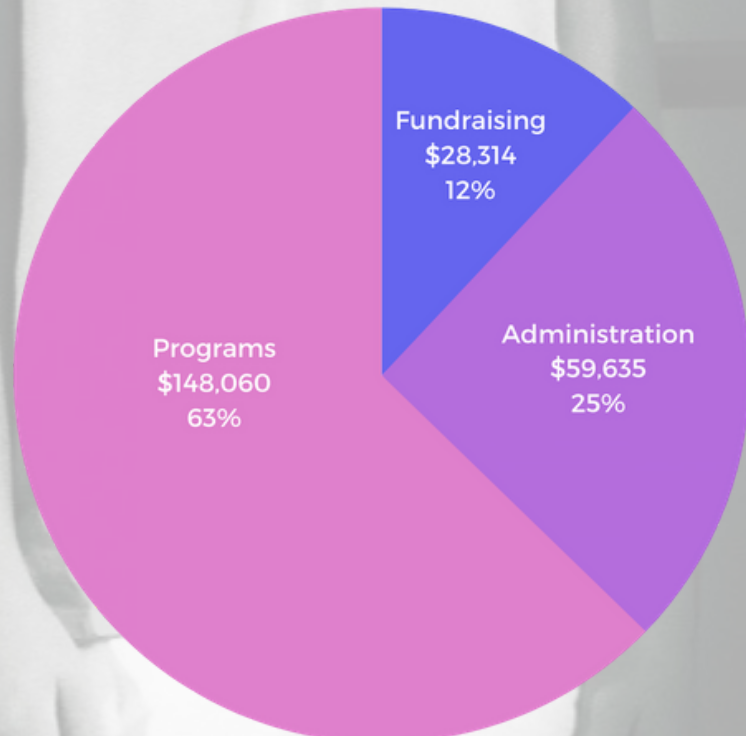
Our mission is to inspire creativity, build confidence, and foster community among children of all ages through the group songwriting process.

Because of you, we have:

- successfully transitioned our workshops to the online format;
- written over 70 songs with over 1,700 kids and senior citizens in schools, libraries, and online;
- created an online concert series to showcase regional and national artists, raising over \$15,000 for musicians whose gigs were canceled due to Covid;
- staged 5 performances of our KPA original musical, *The Talented Clementine*, at the RAAC Community Theatre;
- piloted *Listening and Being Heard*--a songwriting/dialogue workshop for teens;
- released a 4-song EP, *Staring Out My Window*-- reflections from a year at a distance
